## <u> President/ Grand Slam Report – Kevin Crousen</u>

Kevin talked about getting ready for the Grand Slam, and gave the Grand Slam Report:

GRAND SLAM REPORT The Grand Slam Committee met and went over the needs for the Slam on May 15, 2017. The ATA will be hosting the Player's Party on Sunday, June 11, 2017.

The ATA has purchased the following:

12 Benches - 4 to Mann MS, Madison MS, and Wylie JH - \$2820.00 25 Net Straps have been purchased to go to various Middle Schools - \$175.00 12 Scorekeepers were purchased – 8 to Abilene Country Club and 4 to Rose Park - \$779.40 8 – Rol Dri's – 4 to Rose Park and 4 to Abilene Country Club- \$519.60 Court Numbers were created and donated to ATA for the 5 middle schools and 2 high schools - \$0 1100 shirts will be purchased to give to the Player's with ATA's Logo and Sponsor Logos on the back. Approximately \$8,000 (Sponsorship money was raised) 8 tents have been purchased – 3 for Vendor's village and one for each of the middle schools for shade or site directors. \$695.22 5 sets of Canopy Weight Bags - \$114.75 Raffle & Meal Tickets - \$56.54 Food Truck Deposits and permits for Food Trucks and ATA - \$200.00 Ice Trailer and 1000lbs of ice - \$250 ATA will be purchasing Volunteer shirts with our logo.

The ATA will host the Vendor's Village and have 3 booths: Selling our US Open Tickets, Fan Gear, Drinks/Snacks and Chick Fil A. (Asking Junior Players to work/volunteer to help run these booths) Vendor's Village will be Friday the 9th-Wednesday the 14th)

Sponsorships in the amount of \$18,500 was raised to help cover various expenses. This includes court costs, and meals for officials, site directors and tournament staff, and Player Shirts

In-kind Sponsorships of approximately \$4,000 was given (water /drinks for volunteers, player party)(chick fil A) (gifts for raffles for player's party)
